Do Not Hot Swap Lens

Applies to the Following Projectors	Prepared for
DHD700, DHD800, DS+750	Christie Customer Service Christie Field Application Engineers (FAE) Christie Dealers

When using a Christie DHD700, DHD800, or DS+750, the projector **must** be powered down, or operating in standby mode during the removal and installation of the projection lens. Removing and installing a projection lens with the projector powered on (hot swapping) may damage one of the resistors in the lens detection circuitry, causing the projector to fail and display a “Lens incorrectly fitted!” error.

Damage resulting from a hot swap of the projection lens may void the projector warranty. Any issue reported before publication of this bulletin will be covered under warranty. If necessary, please contact Christie technical support for additional information.
